Final Production Sequence

- Student media practicum
 - Six credits
 - Taken in two sequential semesters
 - Classes in advanced community reporting
 - Students hold down news-driven campus and surrounding community beats
- Credit/no-credit practicum for repeaters

Student Publication Imperative

- The student broadcast station and the student newspaper **MUST MERGE** into a new, single-channel multimedia news medium
- Entry: junior-class standing; completed production sequence
- Uniform number of stories/semester; function as reporting staff while taking the courses
- May be editors once the sequence is completed

A Few More Things

- Student work is collected immediately prior to its entry into the news editing process
- Sequence teachers may not serve as publication advisers concurrently
- Non-majors may take credit/no-credit course
